Omron Foundation, Inc. Contributes \$5,000 Towards Louisiana Flood Relief Efforts

HOFFMAN ESTATES, IL (August 23, 2016)—OMRON Foundation, Inc. has contributed \$5,000 to assist with relief for those affected by the devastating floods in Louisiana, particularly in the hardest hit areas of East Baton Rouge, Livingston, St. Helena, and Tangipahoa. The donation was made to Direct Relief, a nonprofit medical assistance and disaster relief agency who is providing emergency shipments of tetanus vaccines, wound care supplies, insulin and other diabetic supplies, and medical outreach backpacks.

Direct Relief is also partnering with healthcare providers in setting up emergency medical modules designed to meet the needs of 100 patients for approximately 3 to 5 days. In addition, Omron Healthcare, Inc. is sending blood pressure monitors, stethoscopes, and nebulizers to aid in the response.

“We would like to extend our support to those affected by the recent flooding in Louisiana. Our thoughts and wishes continue to be with those affected by the flooding as well as those recovering from disasters elsewhere in the US and around the world” said Nigel Blakeway, Omron Foundation President and CEO of Omron Management Center of America, Inc.
